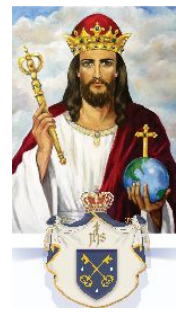
Preparing oneself for the end of the world
