

**Today's Introit** takes from Psalm 73 verses 20, 19, 22, 23, & 1. We review them scripturally then understand them in relation to today's feast.

**Psalm 73** is paraphrased: "A prayer of the Church under grievous persecution." The liturgical Introit omits the verses in parenthesis and makes some minor additions.

20. **Have regard to thy covenant:** (for they that are obscure of the earth have been filled with the dwellings of iniquity.) 19. (Deliver not up to beasts the souls that confess to thee:) **and forget not to the end the souls of thy poor.** 22. **Arise, O God, judge thy own cause:** (remember thy reproaches with which foolish man has reproached thee all the day.) 23. **Forget not the voices of thy enemies:** (the pride of them that hate thee ascends continually.)

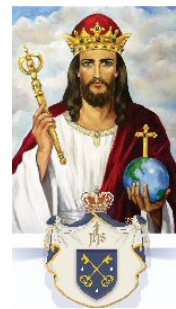
Having lamented the subjugation of the holy city, Jerusalem, and attacks upon the faith by foreign powers, as well as any prophet to guide the way, David tries appeasing the wrath of God (which allows such things to happen): **Have regard to thy covenant**, "if you will not regard us, regard the covenant with our fathers." *Deliver not up to beasts* St. Bellarmine applies to the persecution of Antiochus Epiphanes (Greek conqueror of 2<sup>nd</sup> c. BC) as he never entirely annihilated the Israelites as did Nabuchodosor (Babylonian conqueror of 6<sup>th</sup> c. BC) and Titus and Vespasian (Roman conquerors who leveled Jerusalem in 70 AD); **forget not to the end the souls of thy poor** "remember those who beg at the gates of your mercy."

Then David persuades anew: **Arise, O God, judge thy own cause** "defend thyself, the Hebrew has (done so), now recall yourself the offenses daily heaped upon your dignity." The Psalmist concludes, **Forget not the voices of thy enemies...** it is a request that God ever punish those who ever punish Him.

1. **O God, why has thou cast us off unto the end? Why is thy wrath enkindled against the sheep of thy pasture?**

Verse 1, introduces the tenor of the whole: St. Robert Bellarmine says David speaks for the Jewish people decrying the oppression by king Antiochus: **O God, why has thou cast us off unto the end?** This is no fixed decree, but rather the people felt this way and were fearful of the future... "you deal with us as if you had cast us off forever." The later petition, 'remember the souls of thy poor' is a proof of this meaning.

**The Feast of the 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost** recalls the virtues of faith and hope... and gratitude. The Epistle: The promise to Abraham has been fulfilled in Christ; the Gospel: the Samaritan alone returns to thank Jesus and is thereby fully cured. God ever regards His covenant; a thought to anchor us with a firm hope that Heaven will be ours one day... if we are faithful. God knows our poverty (human weakness) and our enemies (world, flesh, devil); we may fail but by weakness not malice – with a good heart, a humble mind, and a thankful spirit, let us proceed to our Goal sure of being made whole one day.
